## **PLAYBOY ENTERTAINMENT'S "SEXCETRA" FEATURES SPECIAL ON DE MUSEE'S ART TITLED "THE BODY AS ART".**

Playboy Entertainment has produced a 10-minute segment about my erotic art for their *SEXCETRA* show titled "Erotica! The Body As Art". Filming was completed mid-April 1999 and aired on the Playboy Channel on July 23 of that year. "My husband approached Richard P. Rosetti, the president of the Worldwide Productions Div. of the Playboy Entertainment Group, Inc., with the idea of a sequel video, revisiting the studio, the models, and the artist after years. After an initial meeting where Mr. Rosetti & Vice President Eric S. Deutch reviewed my portfolio and videotape of the original Playboy video, I was introduced to Frank Martin, President of 11th Day Productions. 11th Day is under contract to produce 10 one-hour shows for Sexcetra, each with six 10-minute segments. Director Alea Silverstein was assigned to the DeMusée project.

I met with Alea where we mapped out three filming sessions; 1st) film the models in the studio during the photo session; 2nd) filming me painting the art based on the photo session: and 3rd) a final filming during the unveiling of the art at my gallery showing "Erotica! The Body As Art" on April 10.

Below are a few of the photos shot during the documentary. Many of the photos are the basis of a new body of erotic fantasy paintings. The entire process was documented in the Playboy video.
